Step 1: Register with Parks & Recreation—\$172.00pp

Registration includes the ski club transportation and supervision for the trips. This can be completed online, over the phone, or in person. Contact information is located on the bottom of this page.

Step: Purchase you lift tickets (required), lessons and/or rentals (optional) through Mohawk.

Your Parks & Recreation receipt will include a link for our Mohawk Portal where you will purchase your lift tickets (mandatory). Optional: Lessons (sold as 3 or 4 packs only) and rentals. See seasonal rental info below.

Rentals: \$140.00 +tax (see seasonal rental info below)

Additional Important Information:

- Once payment has been made, no refunds can be given for any portion of the program, including students who might miss an evening due to illness or other circumstances.
- We highly recommend that participants wear helmets.
- Beginners must register for 4 lessons.

<u>Volunteers Needed!</u> We are in need of parent volunteers for chaperones! All chaperones will receive a free lift ticket to use on the night(s) they volunteer. Don't ski? No problem! Having chaperones in the lodge is needed. We will ask for volunteers to chaperone between 1 and 4 weeks, depending on the number of volunteers. We have scheduled a preseason meeting with all chaperones on Tuesday, December 17th, 6:00—6:45 p.m. in Room 133 of Town Hall. If you are planning on chaperoning, please make every effort to attend.

Seasonal Equipment Rentals: If you need to rent equipment, we recommend you consider seasonal rentals as opposed to renting each trip from Mohawk. Seasonal rentals are similar in cost and your child will have the same equipment throughout the winter. And, if they ski outside of ski club, you will not have rent again. The kind folks at Ski Haus, 162 Danbury Rd, New Milford have fitted many of our participants with equipment over the years.
